

WHAT TO EXPECT HERE

Our university is divided into the three schools of Design, Engineering and Business, offering you a total of 21 bachelor's and 22 master's degree programs. It usually takes three to four years to complete a bachelor's degree, which then gives you your first academic qualification to enter the professional world. Alternatively, you can further develop your expertise in a master's degree program, which is a prerequisite for a subsequent doctorate.

Closeness to our students is very important to us, which we cultivate through intensive mentoring, small teaching groups, and numerous joint projects. A strong practical focus in teaching and research is always a top priority here. Our part-time dual and job-integrated degree programs enable you to study parallel to your vocational training or job.

International exchange is an additional key component of life at our university. This includes stays abroad, double master's degree programs, language classes and classes in intercultural skills, as well as visiting lecturers from abroad. Our network includes more than 140 partner universities around the world – from Sweden to Tanzania, from Chile to New Zealand.

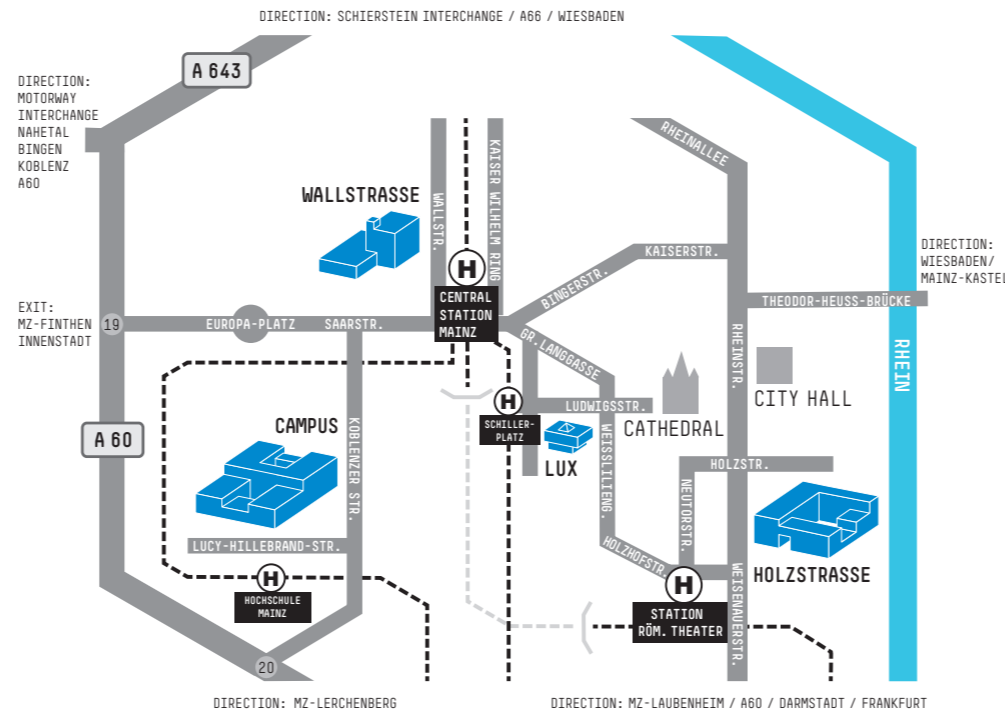
