

HOW TO ACT IN AN EMERGENCY

How to act in mass assault cases

Report it: police emergency no. **110**

- **WHO** is reporting it?
- **WHAT** happened? (number of assailants, weapons, location, number of victims, hostages)
- **WERE** did it happen? (address, floor, room)
- **WAIT** for additional questions!

How to act in an emergency

- Stay in the rooms!
- Keep doors closed/locked!
- Look for the safest corner in the room and move out of the line of sight.
- Stay away from windows and doors.
- **Alert the police by dialing 110**
- **Put mobile phones in silent mode!**
- Stay calm
- Evacuation is only done by the police

If you find suspicious items

Safety first!

Get away from the suspicious item before calling for help. Also instruct bystanders to move away from the danger zone.

Making the notification

- **WHAT** aroused your suspicion? (size, description)
- **Where** is the item located? (exact location, dangers/risks, access paths)
- **WHEN** was the item found?
- **WHO** found the item or noticed something suspicious?

To help you assess it:

- Suspicious items tend to be unusual (in terms of location or the time they are found, for example)
- Suspicious items tend to look inconspicuous

Situations with an acute threat

In the event of an acute threat, the police recommend:

- **Assess the situation**
- **If necessary, make an emergency call**
- **Be active, don't let fear paralyze you**
- **Get help**
- **Keep in contact with the other person** (eye contact, communication)
- **Do not behave aggressively**
- **Do not threaten or insult**
- **Do not disparage the other person**
- **Avoid physical contact**
- **Never use weapons**

The police recommend downloading the **KATWARN** app, which provides public warnings on your mobile phone.

Managing threats/conflicts

If you are experiencing any of these threatening situations or observe any threatening behavior, we ask you to please contact us:

- **Any form of physical violence**
- **The threat of violence** (no matter whether in writing or spoken)
- **The bringing or showing of weapons**
- **Extreme expression of violent fantasies**
- **Sexual harassment or assault**
- **Stalking**
- **Threats of suicide or suicide attempts**

You are also welcome to contact us in order to discuss situations with the potential for massive conflict that are at risk of escalating.

How to act in case of fire

Stay calm!

Report



1. Activate the manual fire alarm the fire call point or call:
Fire dept. 112, Police 110
2. Internal notification of threat management 06131 628-**4444**

- **WHO** is calling?
- **WHAT** happened?
- **WHERE** did something happen?
- **HOW MANY** people are affected?
- **WAIT** for additional questions!

Get to safety



Attempt to wall hydrant!



- Take people at risk along!
- Close doors!
- Follow marked escape routes and go to assembly points
- Do not use the elevator!
- Wait for instructions!
- Use fire extinguishers, extinguish!
- Only attempt to extinguish small fires/ fires just breaking out.
- Anyone not needed must vacate the danger zone.

What to do in the event of an accident

Stay calm!

Call the emergency number **112** and provide information:

- **WHERE** did the accident happen?
building, section, floor, room
- **WHAT** happened?
Fire, chemical burn, poisoning, fall, ...
- **HOW MANY** injured people?
- **WHAT** injuries? Type and place on body
- **WAIT** for additional questions!
Important information could be missing.

Also inform Facility Management
(see “**Internal Phone Numbers**“ section).

Provide FIRST AID

- Secure the scene of the accident
- Attend to the injured
- Follow instructions

Brief rescue personnel and clear away onlookers

A list of first-aid providers can be found near the escape and rescue plans at the entrance to the building
