Part-time and cooperative study programmes make it possible for our students to combine their studies with professional activities.

Integrated international degree programmes, internationally accredited master's degree programmes and dual degrees, the promotion of study abroad semesters, exchange programmes for university staff as well as language courses to intensify students' foreign language competence play a major role in this domain.

Our University places particular value on maintaining a close relationship with its students. The good relations between students and University teaching staff are supported by intensive advising, small class sizes and many joint projects.

BACHELOR/MASTER

Our range of offers comprises 17 bachelor's and 22 master's degree programmes. In three to four years, the bachelor's degree provides students with an initial academic qualification and can open the door to professional life or a further qualification in the form of a master's degree programme. The completion of the master's degree allows graduates to undertake a doctoral degree.
