PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

In three semesters, our degree program teaches you legal and economics skills that are indispensable in international legal matters. It prepares you for a responsible position in structuring and managing business transactions with a cross-border dimension in the future. The focus is on compliance and international contract drafting.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

In the first two semesters, lectures are held on Friday afternoons and Saturdays, as well as in a week-long block. Examinations are spread out throughout the semester, where possible at the end of the respective module. In the third semester you will write your master's thesis. In addition, you will learn the basics of WTO law in a seminar. The program concludes with the awarding of the academic degree Master of Laws (LL.M.).

Moreover, you also have the opportunity to obtain the qualification 'Compliance Officer with TÜV Rheinland-certified qualification' with our cooperation partner.

PROSPECTS

This degree program is designed for professional advancement, especially within an existing employment situation. You can find professional positions in industry, commerce, banks, and insurance companies, as well as in the service sector and with associations.
