PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

You will be prepared to execute management functions in a degree program combined with your job. The on-the-job character of this master's degree enables a close interconnection of academic education and practical application through job-related activities. The objective is a comprehensive management education with a certain degree of specialization. Intended learning outcomes: Acquisition of comprehensive management know-how, establishment of international business skills, and the development of leadership abilities and digital expertise.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The degree program has a modular structure, which means that the relevant content is covered in complete modules. The international approach is ensured by international topics in the modules, the completion of one module in English each semester, and the field trip abroad during the 3rd semester.

PROSPECTS

The degree program prepares you to take on demanding specialized and managerial tasks in private companies and public enterprises in higher-level civil service. With the M.Sc. in Management, you have a degree that enables you to take advantage of career opportunities flexibly and independent of industries. The degree also qualifies you to pursue a doctorate.
