PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

You graduated with a non-business degree and are now looking for the latest business know-how in theory and practice that will enable you to enter other professional fields? Then start your interdisciplinary, practical advanced training now with our master's degree program in Business Administration, which will introduce you to commercial topics, teach you business management skills, and hone your entrepreneurial leadership abilities.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

In the first two semesters of the program, students learn the fundamentals and methods of business administration, along with legal and economic foundations. Management and leadership topics are focused on in the third semester, supplemented, among other things, by three company projects. The international management seminar that includes a trip to a different cultural and economic region expands on these topics in the fourth semester. The fourth semester is also when you will write your master's thesis, which preferably addresses a problem taken from the real world applying the methods learned.

PROSPECTS

Our master's degree significantly expands your professional profile and can substantially improve your career development opportunities, because management functions require not only non-economic knowledge, they also call for economic know-how and pronounced management skills. The program concludes with the awarding of the academic degree Master of Science (M.Sc.) and lays the foundation for pursuing a doctorate.
